BRAIPRD seeks application from interested retired Engineers (retired as SE or above) with experience of working for at least 10 years directly in the sphere of rural development and extensive experience in managing / supervising/ leading innovative activities in the rural development sector like 'cost effective housing technology', 'innovative technology in road construction/ construction of bridges/ culverts', 'application of waste management technologies', etc. for Retainership with the Institute for short term period (till 26 January 2021)

Along with the application, the applicant will have to submit (online) evidence of work (not certificate, but project note/ project report etc.) to be reviewed by the authority.

Since the services of the selected retainer will also be used for coordinating training courses in the rural engineering sector, her/ his experience in conducting training in rural engineering as the lead coordinator will be considered as added advantage.

An online assessment of the applications received will be conducted by the Committee formed for selection of retainers for the Institute on 13 October 2020 at 12 noon.

During assessment, the applicants will have to make a presentation (online) by sharing her/ his desktop following the given link on the innovative works in the rural development sector done by her/ him.

Interested candidates are to apply through e-mail addressed to the Director, BRAIPRD and mailed to siprdkalyani@gmail.com by 12th October 2020, 12 noon. On examination of the CV, shortlisted applicants will be called for a interaction/presentation through online meeting platform on 13th October 2020, link for which will be shared only on 12th October 2020, in the afternoon.

The Retainership is expected to commence with effect from 2 November 2020 and expected to continue till 26 January 2021. However, actual assignment will be based on requirement of the Institute.

During the period of assignment, the Retainer will be paid fees @Rs.4000.00 per day of assignment, subject to a minimum of Rs.10,000.00 and a maximum of Rs.88,000.00 (equivalent to 22 days of assignment) or her/ his last pay minus pension, whichever is lower. For the assignment she/ he may work from the Institute / in the field or from remote location (as per requirement and suitability). For visit to the office, s/he will be reimbursed actual fuel cost of her/his vehicle. For field visit, she/he is authorized to hire vehicle, which will be reimbursed.


